
WASHINGTON, D.C. – The U.S. Department of Transportation’s Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) on October 5 [announced](#) a new award package valued at almost \$8 million that will fund 10 U.S. pipeline safety and R&D projects. The projects will help develop innovative solutions to further improve pipeline safety.
