- **Global reach (and influence) through exports:** When America's allies face fuel and product shortages in other parts of the world, the United States is able to provide support via trade. American refiners are the largest suppliers of fuel and products to the global market, making us a lifeline during times of uncertainty and disruption elsewhere.

U.S. refiners are not just domestic suppliers — though they make more fuel than the United States even consumes — they're also essential to keeping and restoring balance to global energy markets.
