
WASHINGTON, D.C. – Statement from Chet Thompson, President and CEO of the American Fuel & Petrochemical Manufacturers (AFPM) on H.R.1, the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, which passed in the U.S. House of Representatives today:

“Today’s House vote for comprehensive tax reform is a welcome and long overdue step to a more competitive US manufacturing sector. This plan modernizes the tax code and eliminates market-distorting credits, including those for electric vehicles, which will stimulate economic growth and create jobs.
