AFPM Safety Awards Program

The presentation of the AFPM Safety Award plaques is part of a comprehensive safety awards program which the Association's Safety & Health Committee has developed to promote safety performance achievements in the petroleum refining, petrochemical manufacturing, and contracting industries and to publicly recognize the excellent record of safety in operations which the industries and contractors have achieved.

AFPM Safety Awards are based on records kept for employees in accordance with OSHA record keeping requirements as defined by law and entered on the OSHA 300A summary form and API RP 754, Process Safety Performance Indicators for the Refining and Petrochemical Industries.

Distinguished Safety Award

AFPM's most prestigious award, the Distinguished Safety Award (DSA) recognizes the **top** member company refineries and petrochemical plants that have attained a sustained, exemplary level of safety performance in the domestic refining and petrochemical manufacturing industries. The DSA Selection Committee carefully examines the safety performance records of individual plant locations using the specific screening and selection criteria detailed below to identify this year's industry safety leaders.

Elite Gold Safety Award

This award is traditionally presented to approximately the top five percent of member company refineries and petrochemical plants that have exhibited superior safety performance and program innovation as determined by the DSA Selection Committee.

Elite Silver Safety Award

This award is traditionally presented to approximately the top ten percent of member company refineries and petrochemical plants that have exhibited excellent industry safety performance and program innovation as determined by the DSA Selection Committee.

Innovation Award

The Innovation Awards to recognize refineries, petrochemical facilities, and their contractors that have unique and innovative programs or practices that effectively improve the site's safety performance for either occupational or process safety.

AFPM Safety Award Recipients

The 30th Annual Safety Awards honors 33 regular member companies, 45 refineries, 48 petrochemical plants with 125 awards. Thirty associate member companies with 300 awards in their efforts in 110 facilities.

Distinguished Safety Award

Screening Criteria

In order to qualify for the DSA, a facility must first pass the screening criteria as described below:

- 1. A location must achieve the following requirements for the calendar year:
 - a. an employee total recordable incidence rate (TRIR) of 0.30 or less,
 - b. a contractor total recordable incidence rate (TRIR) of 0.30 or less,
- A location must have had no employee workplace related fatalities and no non-employee (contractor, visitor, etc.) workplace related fatalities for the previous five consecutive years.

A location must answer **no** to the following questions:

- Did the location experience a community evacuation or sheltering event, or worker/ contractor hospitalization (admitted for treatment) during the evaluation period?
- 2. Did the location experience a recordable injury where any of the following caused or contributed to the injury during the evaluation year?
- Failure to isolate hazardous energy
- Opening process equipment improperly prepared for maintenance
- Improperly prepared or hazardous confined space
- Improperly prepared or hazardous excavation
- Any falls from height (>4 feet)
- Any Tier 1 or 2 PSE
- Contact /exposure to hazardous materials
 - HH2S/HF/hydrocarbon/corrosives/electricity/radiation
- Crane or rigging failure
- Caught by machinery or struck by debris, equipment, or falling objects
- Electrical work or hot work on equipment not verified as hydrocarbon free
- Failure to verify work permit
- Failure in PPE chosen for the task or the incorrect PPE for the task
- Use of the correct tool incorrectly or use of incorrect tool for the task
- Deliberately bypassing safeguards or interlocks
- Community evacuation or sheltering event
- 3. Did the location have any API RP Tier 1 Process Safety Events (PSE) that **required** notification to the National Response Center during the evaluation year?

Selection Criteria

After passing the screening criteria, the candidate facility's overall safety performance record will be evaluated by the selection committee based on the applicant's written application. Those sites that are in the running for the DSA and Elite Gold awards participate in in-person interviews with representatives of the DSA Selection Committee.

Safety Achievement Award

Screening Criteria

In order to qualify for the **Safety Achievement Award**, a facility must first pass the following screening criteria.

- 1. A location must have had no employee workplace related fatalities and no non-employee (contractor, visitor, etc.) workplace related fatalities for the reporting year.
- A location must answer **NO** to the following questions to pass the screening criteria and be eligible to apply for the Safety Achievement Award:
- 2. Did the location experience an injury to an **employee and/** or contractor that required hospitalization (admitted for treatment) during the evaluation period?
- 3. Did the location experience a **employee and/or contractor recordable injury** where any of the following caused or contributed to the injury during the evaluation year?
- Failure to isolate hazardous energy
- Opening process equipment improperly prepared for maintenance
- Improperly prepared or hazardous confined space
- Improperly prepared or hazardous excavation
- Any falls from height (>4 feet)
- Any Tier 1 or 2 PSE
- Contact /exposure to hazardous materials
- H2S/HF/hydrocarbon/corrosives/electricity/radiation
- Crane or rigging failure
- Caught by machinery or struck by debris, equipment, or falling objects
- Electrical work or hot work on equipment not verified as hydrocarbon free
- Failure to verify work permit
- Failure in PPE chosen for the task or the incorrect PPE for the task
- Use of the correct tool incorrectly or use of incorrect tool for the task
- Deliberately bypassing safeguards or interlocks
- No community evacuation or sheltering event

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The American Fuel & Petrochemical Manufacturers (AFPM) has announced the winners of the 2021 Annual Safety Awards, part of the refining and petrochemical industries ongoing mission to enhance and recognize outstanding workplace safety. The awards, considered the industries' premier awards, are part of a comprehensive program developed by the AFPM Safety and Health Committee to promote safe operations in the refining and petrochemical industries. They also recognize facilities that have outstanding occupational and process safety performance.

"The U.S. refining and petrochemical industries continued to deliver on their commitment to the health and safety of our workforce, our communities, and the environment last year. The AFPM Safety Awards proudly honor the sites that have risen to the top, sites that never fail to focus on safety and continuously look for ways to improve, benefitting not only our employees and facilities, but also supporting community safety and improving environmental protection," said Chet Thompson.

The refining and petrochemical industries' commitment to safety is reflected in their records, where they have ranked in the top tenth percentile of more than 500 manufacturing industries tracked by the government over the last decade.

The highest honor, the *Distinguished Safety Award*, is awarded to the top sites with outstanding safety performance, program innovation and safety leadership. This honor was awarded to four facilities this year for achieving a sustained, exemplary level of safety performance, they are: LyondellBasell Industries – Morris Site; Marathon Petroleum Company – St. Paul Park Refinery; Monroe Energy LLC – Trainer Refinery and Phillips 66 – Sweeny Refinery.



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The *Elite Gold Award*, which recognizes facilities with safety performances in the top five percentile and that have demonstrated superior and consistent safety performance, program innovation and leadership, has been given to ten facilities this year: Chevron Phillips Chemical Company – Borger Plant; ExxonMobil Chemical Company – Baton Rouge Plastics Plant; ExxonMobil Chemical Company – Baton Rouge Polyolefins; LyondellBasell Industries – Bayport Complex; LyondellBasell Industries – Clinton Site; LyondellBasell Industries – Tuscola Plant; Marathon Petroleum Corporation – Anacortes Refinery; Marathon Petroleum Corporation – Louisiana Refining Division; Phillips 66 – Billings Refinery and Valero Energy Corporation – St. Charles Refinery.

The *Elite Silver Award* recognizes those sites that have attained top industry safety performance for the application year and demonstrated excellent program innovation and leadership over time. The Elite Silver Award recognizes the top ten percentile of industry safety and this year was awarded to 11 facilities: Chevron Phillips Chemical Company – Drilling Specialties Conroe Plant; ExxonMobil Chemical Company – Baytown Chemical Plant; ExxonMobil Chemical Company – Baytown Olefins Plant; Exxon Mobil Refining & Supply – Billings Refinery; Exxon Mobil Refining & Supply – Joliet Refinery; Flint Hills Resources, LLC – Houston Chemical; LyondellBasell Industries – Louisiana Integrated PolyEthylene JV LLC (LKO); Phillips 66 – Bayway Refinery; Valero Energy Corporation – Texas City Refinery; Valero Energy Corporation – Three Rivers Refinery and Valero Energy Corporation – Wilmington Asphalt Plant.
